

TAURANGA PRIMARY SCHOOL (1991)

ENROLMENT SCHEME

Effective from 01/01/2020

The guidelines for development and operating of enrolment schemes are issued under section 11G (3) of the Education Act 1989 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone boundary described below (and shown on the attached map) shall be entitled to enrol at the school.

Starting from the Tauranga Harbour Bridge (SH2), the enrolment zone boundary travels south along the coastline to the northern entrance to the Hairini Bridge. The boundary does not cross the bridge, but continues around the coastline to reach 71 Burrows Street (this address is excluded from the zone).

From this point the boundary travels south, along the coastline, to capture 49 Scantlebury Street, and then northward, around all addresses on Scantlebury Street to reach 15^{th} Avenue.

The boundary then travels north-west along 15^{th} Avenue, capturing addresses on both sides of this road, to the intersection Edgecumbe Road, 15^{th} Avenue and Tamatea Arikinui Drive (SH2).

From this point the boundary continues along the northern side of Tamatea Arikinui Drive (SH2), and then onto Takitimu Drive (SH2 and 29). The boundary continues along Takitimu Drive, crossing the Kopurererua Stream, to 141 Birch Avenue.

The boundary travels north-east along the rear of addresses on Birch Avenue to 25 Cypress Street. The boundary then travels along the rear boundary of address of 30, 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35 Redmond Street and continues along the rear boundary of addresses on Robins Road.

From the rear of 23A-C Robins Road, the zone boundary travels along the western boundary of 100 Waihi Road. The boundary crosses Waihi Road at the intersection with Judea Road, and continues north along Judea Road, capturing addresses on Dell Way, to the intersection of Judea Road, Sutherland Road, Churchill Road, and Ngai Tamarawaho Crescent.

From this intersection the boundary travels down the centre of Te Kaponga Street, capturing evennumbered addresses only, to the coastline off the northern end of this street.

The boundary travels east along the coastline all the way around to Tauranga Harbour Bridge (SH2).

Special Programmes

The school does not operate a special programme

Out of Zone Enrolments

Each year the Board of Trustees will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The Board will publish this information by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will be specific a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority:

- **First priority** does not apply as this school does not operate a special programme.
- Second priority must be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.
- Third priority must be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.
- **Fourth priority** must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.
- **Fifth priority** must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.
- **Sixth priority** must be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, or fifth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions by the Secretary. Under Section 11G (1) of the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship
